

SPECIAL MEETING OF
THE CITY COUNCIL OF LINN VALLEY, KANSAS
July 21, 2020
6:00 pm at the Community Center

Mayor Cindy Smith called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. Present were Council Members Lew Donelson, Jason Jenkins, Brenda Muncy and Robert Suppenbach. Also present was Corey Murrison, Public Safety Director, and Karen Siffring, City Clerk.

The Council reviewed a contract for construction of the Linn Valley City Hall Entry Roof with Nuzum Enterprises. Council Member Muncy made a motion to approve the contract in the amount of \$5,950 for construction of the entry roof. The motion was seconded by Council Member Suppenbach. The motion passed 4-0.

2021 BUDGET

The Council discussed the proposed budget presented by Clerk Siffring. Director Murrison responded to questions about a new siren. Cost would be between \$20,000 and \$22,000. Getting grants was thought to be an option. Council Member Suppenbach made a motion to send the budget to the County Clerk with directed changes. Council Member Muncy seconded the motion and the motion passed 4-0.

Director Murrison informed the Council that Officer Jenkins will be attending the Police Academy from August 17 through November 20th. Murrison also inquired about moving forward with the gun range. Mayor Smith suggested forming a Gun Range Study Committee at the August meeting.

Councilman Jenkins made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Councilman Suppenbach and passed 4-0. The meeting adjourned at 6:55 pm.
