Council President Suppenbach led the council and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance. Invocation given by Council Member John Weers.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Council President Suppenbach made the motion to accept the February 10, 2025, minutes as written. The motion was seconded by Council Member Hemphill, motion carried 5-0.

WATER PROJECT

Jason Hoskinson, BG Consultants, updated the council. He reported that the bid opening was on February 14, 2025. The winning bid was Hettinger Excavation, out of Drexel Missouri has the lowest bid. The bid was slightly over our 2019 budget, due to inflation. This leaves us with a 4 million shortage. Mr. Hoskinson recommended that we consider going back to USDA for additional funds.

Council President Suppenbach made a motion to move into a ten (10) minute Executive Session for Legal Contractual matters, to return at 6:30pm. The motion was seconded by Council Member Hemphill, carried 5-0. The council moved into the Executive Session at 6:20pm.

The City Council meeting was called back to order at 6:30pm by Mayor Donelson with no action taken.

Council President Suppenbach made a motion to allow the Mayor to enter into negotiations with USDA for a loan amount of 4.5 million with approval of legal counsel. Council Member Weers seconded the motion, carried 5-0.

Mr. Hoskinson reported that KDHE has returned the paperwork with a few items that need attention. BG should have the corrections made and resubmitted next week.

Dear Mr. Donelson:

As you may recall, I attended the February 24, 2025 City Council meeting to discuss the bid opening and project funding for the City's 2024 Distribution System Improvements Project. As a result of the discussion, the Council authorized pursuing additional funding from USDA-RD (Agency) in an amount sufficient to cover the entire Project (base bid plus all add alternates).

I subsequently worked with City Staff and the USDA-RD to provide the Agency with the information needed to process a request for an additional \$4.5 million in federal funding. The Agency has reviewed the request and has offered to provide the requested additional funding. Furthermore, the additional funding will consist of \$1.0 million in grant and \$3.5 million in additional loan and the loan will be held at a lower interest rate than intermediate rate. In my experience and my opinion, this is wonderful news and it's not too often that additional grant funding is injected into a Project like this.

However, this news requires a quick response from the City of Linn Valley as to whether or not the City will accept the additional funding offer and move forward with the Project. Based on this information, BG Consultants, Inc. recommends the City of Linn Valley consider the following City Council actions relative to this project.

- 1. Consider accepting additional federal funding from USDA RD.
- 2. Possible Council Actions:
 - a. I move to accept and approve the USDA-RD Letter of Conditions Amendment No. 1.
 - b. I move to approve the Request for Obligation of Funds, the Loan Resolution, and the Grant Agreement.
- 3. Award the Construction Contract: I move to award the construction contract to Hettinger Excavating, LLC in the amount of \$15,849,057.00 for the Base Bid and Add Alternates 1-6.

I plan to attend the Monday March 10, 2025 City Council meeting to go over the Funding information and our recommendations above.
