



WATER LINE INFORMATION FOR RV OWNERS

When the water project was initially planned, meter placements were determined based on which properties already had water meters—through Linn Valley or RWD #1—and which properties the POA had been supplying with water via in-ground storage tanks. Now that the project is underway and pricing has been established, several RV owners have indicated they do not wish to have a water meter installed with a monthly payment, as they typically occupy their properties for only three to four months per year.

Initially, the Council planned to proceed with the original meter list. However, due to several new homes currently under construction with water lines already running in front of their properties, the decision has been made to allow RV owners who do not want a meter to opt out of installation. Any meters not installed at RV sites may be reassigned to these new residences.

The City would like to begin installing meters on Elm Street and the adjacent side roads as soon as possible; however, we want to avoid installing meters that are not wanted. A map showing the area scheduled for the initial meter installations is included. Any property owner who does not wish to have a meter installed must contact City Hall at (913) 757-2926 as soon as possible so their property can be removed from the installation list.

Please note that once a meter is installed and water service is available to that meter—whether it is connected or not—the property will be billed the \$65.00 monthly minimum. This policy applies to all RVs located on camping or multi-purpose lots. If you are currently on the meter list and do not wish to receive a meter, please contact City Hall promptly.
